#### VACATION POLICY

The Play Schools generously offer our families two weeks of "tuition free vacation time" annually from August to August. You must notify your director of your child(ren)'s absence in advance and it must be a full week at a time (no split weeks). Vacation weeks cannot be used toward your required two week notice if withdrawing from our school. Vacation slips are located in the front entry.

The two weeks of annual vacation time starts over August 2017 for all enrolled children.

# NEW AND UPDATED SAFE SLEEP REGULATIONS

Every October we focus our community calendar on SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome) which is something that is very near and dear to our hearts as the owners of The Play Schools. The Play School always makes a charitable donation in October to help funding towards research and to help ensure all parents are able to have safe sleeping areas for their infants. This past October the American Academy of Pediatrics released new advice for parents to help protect their newborns from SIDS. We place SIDS prevention as one of the most important aspects of our infant programs here at each of our schools. We would like to share with you the newest findings to ensure you know the safest information for your child while at home.

#### Important Rules for Infant Care:

- \*The infant is always placed to sleep on their back on a firm sleep surface such as a safety-approved crib mattress, in a safety-approved crib, porta-crib, or play yard. The infant should **never** be placed to sleep on a sofa, chair, or adult bed.
- \*There should be no soft or loose bedding placed underneath the infant; the mattress should fit snugly in the crib and the crib sheet should fit tightly around the mattress.

\*No toys, soft bedding, crib gyms, mobiles, or mirrors should be in or attached to an infant's crib. \*The infant is kept away from any area where smoking has occurred.

- \*When the infant is awake and **being watched by a caregiver**, it is desirable to place him or her on the stomach for "tummy time".
- \*If the infant falls asleep on another surface (car seat, swing, carrier) they should be immediately removed and placed in a safety approved crib, porta-crib, or pack and play.
- \*Do not swaddle infants using blankets. Swaddling is not recommended in child care. (If you do swaddle infants under 3 months then use a safe swaddler and not a blanket.)

\*The infant is not placed to sleep with a bottle.

#### In Addition:

- **Pacifier use:** Consider offering a clean dry pacifier when placing the infant down to sleep for naps or at night. \*The pacifier does not need to be re-inserted if it falls out
  - \*If infant refuses the pacifier, he or she should not be forced to take it.
- \*For breastfed infants, delay pacifier use until 1 month of age to ensure good onset of breastfeeding.
- \*The pacifier should not be clipped or attached to the infant or the crib (strangulation hazard).

#### New Crib Standards:

Beginning July 28<sup>,</sup> 2011 all cribs manufactured and sold (including resale) must comply with new and improved federal safety standards. The new rules, prohibit the manufacture or sale of traditional drop-side rail cribs, strengthen crib slats and mattress supports, improve the quality of hardware and require more rigorous testing. Cribs manufactured before July 23, 2010 are not likely to be compliant and cribs manufactured between July 24, 2010 and June 27, 2011 are not guaranteed to be compliant either.

#### **New Play Yard Standards:**

#### Effective February 28, 2016

\*Side rails should not form a sharp V when the product is folded.

\*Corner brackets should be strong in order to prevent sharp-edged cracks and to prevent a side-rail collapse. \*The mattress should be sturdy on the play yard floor to prevent children from getting trapped or hurt.

\*The should be no tears in the mesh or fabric and there should be no missing parts, protruding or loose screws or other hardware.

\*No cracks or stress whitening in plastic parts (especially corner brackets)
