Did you know?

Brightwheel automatically sends out weekly tuition invoices every Friday for the upcoming week. If you have a credit that we need to apply such as a vacation credit or payment, we must wait until your statement generates and auto-sends to you before we can go in and update your invoice with additional charges or credits. If you still don't see your credit you believe you are due by Monday, please reach out to your Director for assistance.

SUMMER WITHDRAWS:

The Play School requires a two week notice to withdraw should you be making other arrangements for care for the summer. Any unused vacation credits cannot be applied toward your notice. PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

The Play Schools will be holding Parent/Teacher Conferences from June 25th-June 27th. As of June 1st, each classroom will have a sign-up sheet with 15-minute increments on their door. If you cannot make it during any of the 15minute time-slots, please reach out to your center director. In addition, please know that we conduct this on request at any time of the year as well. At The Play School, we strive to create a comfortable and approachable environment where you can contact your teachers or your director at any time should you have questions, concerns, praises or feedback. We view all our families and staff as an extension of our family so please let us know how we can help you and make your experience at The Play School meaningful.

SEASONAL ITEMS TO NOTE

Although it doesn't quite seem possible, warmer weather is coming soon.

We will be getting outside at every opportunity.

Please make sure you have done the following to ensure your child is ready for outdoor play and warmer weather:

- Check your child's cubby for both seasonal and size-appropriate clothing. Take home those heavy sweaters and fleece lined winter pants and replace with "extra" clothes that are comfortable for this upcoming weather. Make sure you leave an extra pair of socks at school for our indoor gym time.
- Supply your child's teacher with a new, unopened, LABELED bottle of sunscreen. This must be lotion. We cannot accept aerosol sprays due to licensing regulations. (One per child, please. Siblings in different classrooms cannot share.)
- Sign off on the "walking field trip permission slip." See your teachers for more specific information.
