Brightwheel automatically sends out weekly tuition invoices every Friday for the upcoming week. If you have a credit that we need to apply such as a vacation credit or payment, we must wait until your statement generates and auto-sends to you before we can go in and update your invoice with additional charges or credits. If you still don't see your credit you believe you are due by Monday, please reach out to your Director for assistance.

### 2019/2020 REGISTRATION FEES / SUPPLY FEES










We are so proud of all the 4 Kidz Only Summer Club readers! Students from all 3 schools have done an amazing job of reading in the classroom and at home to earn prizes!
